Audiology – Colchester Hospital

All adult patients currently wearing NHS hearing aids do not need a GP referral but can contact us directly for advice or to book an appointment at any of our main hospitals and satellite sites.

Audiology Services - Audiology services in North East Essex

If you are concerned about any loss of hearing you should visit your GP. Your GP may refer you to the ENT (Ear Nose and Throat Department), the Hospital Audiology Service or the Community Audiology Service depending upon your symptoms and medical history.

If your GP suspects you have age-related hearing loss and you are over the age of 50, you may be referred to the Community Audiology service.

We cover North East Essex which includes Colchester and Tendring districts.

You will be contacted to set up an appointment at the Specsavers location of your choice.

During the initial appointment and in the subsequent correspondence you will be provided with your hearing care entitlements, support information and contact details.

Audiology offers a home visit for people who cannot leave their homes.
